

Council Meeting
February 9, 2026

The Maysville Board of Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, February 9, 2026 at 6:00 pm pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.021.

Mayor Ronnie Pearl called the meeting to order with the following members present: Clint Sollars, Darrell Conley, Amy Justus and Larry Zieber.

Also present were City Clerk Pat Fisher-Johnson, Stephanie Ayres, TH Bosler and Peggy Harwood.

The meeting was called to order and Mayor Pearl led us in the pledge followed by a prayer from Alderman Zieber.

Alderman Sollars made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried. This included minutes of the January 26, 2026 meeting and the following checks: Water 7120-7132, Wastewater 3637-3646, Street 4597-4605, General 22216-22229, Pk 1268, SW 1582 and Payroll 11253-11277.

City Clerk reported within this past week she has received complaints about numerous cats within a neighborhood. After discussion, TH will send a letter to the home owner that feeds these cats to let her know that we do have a leash law and all of the cats need to be license and have proof of shots.

Stephanie reported that people with the Scada system were here to see what we need to do to see if our current Scada system will work with new connection point. Then once this is complete the power to the vault can be completed. The City of Maysville did receive their approval of construction which allows us to dispense water.

City Clerk reported there are still issues on the Exhibit A that needs to be completed mainly a capital improvement plan. Mr. Bosler is going to ask for an extension to complete the plan and report back to DNR. Stephanie and City Clerk will start some of the items and work with F/S crew to complete other items.

Alderman Conley made a motion to go into closed session. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Roll call vote: Conley -yes, Zieber – yes, Sollars – yes and Justus – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Zieber made a motion to open into open session. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Roll call vote: Justus – yes, Sollars – yes, Zieber – yes and Conley – yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Conley made a motion to drop the case of trees that were cut down on City property. Seconded by Alderman Justus. Motion carried.

Alderman Sollars reported the guys have done normal daily tasks, repaired the bulk water hose, replaced some meters, picked up some chemicals, been cutting some wood and put rip rap on Willow Brook.

City Clerk asked to change the March board meeting due to the clerk meeting in Columbia. Board agreed to only have one meeting in March unless two is needed. The March meeting will be March 17th.

Next scheduled meeting will be February 23rd, 2026.


With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.
